

Youssef Macary was a citizen of Waterbury, Connecticut since 1962. Born in Zgharta, Lebanon, he immigrated to this country after working his way through school in Brazil. He was fluent in Arabic, Portuguese, English, and French. He served in the US Army as permanent resident before his citizenship. He was a tireless worker and supporter for his family and the entire Lebanese-American community in Greater Waterbury and Connecticut. He even produced a weekly public access show called Eye on Lebanon.

In addition, what many people do not know is that he was a great advocate of education. He put his own children through college, sponsored a number of graduate students from Lebanon during early days of its civil war, and was involved in local parent-teacher associations, citywide parent-teacher councils and advocate groups for gifted education well after his own children left the public school system. His family has put forth this scholarship in his name so that his legacy of sacrifice and his lifelong love of learning and education may continue.

As he once said, "When one of our own succeeds, we all succeed." The scholarship is to be awarded to a deserving high school senior of Lebanese descent pursuing a degree in higher education. Preference is given students pursuing science, technology, engineering, and mathematics (STEM) fields.
